

Quilt Hanging Sleeve

A Hanging Sleeve is a 4-1/2" sleeve running across the top back side of the quilt, wall hanging, or other article you are displaying. A sleeve is required on all hanging items entered in the guild quilt show.

Cut the fabric for the sleeve 9" wide and as long as the width of the article you are hanging.

Fold in half, right sides together, lengthwise. Sew a 1/4" seam. Turn right sides out and press. Hem each of the short ends about 1". Sew the sleeve to the top of your quilt along both long sides using an invisible appliqué stitch that does not go through to the front. The sleeve should not show above the top of the article.

A bar will be inserted through the sleeve to hang the item for display, and the sleeve will protect the quilt from touching the bar.
