In this workshop you will learn that curves are NOT difficult as you think! The block is n old traditional block called "Snake Trail." I thought nobody would sign up for a 'snake' block so I called it "Winding Paths." Acrylic templates are available. There is room for error in the templates, so you don't have to be a perfect stitcher! If you've never done curves, this one is for you! All levels.
